**Wyre Forest District Council Site Allocations and Policies and Kidderminster Central Area  
Action Plans – Recommendation of Main Modifications under Section 20(7c) of the  
Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended)**

I am writing with regard to your examination into the soundness of the above listed Development Plans and further to your recent correspondence to the Programme Officer dated 10<sup>th</sup> December 2012.

I wish to formally request that under Section 20 (7c) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act (2004, as amended), you recommend main modifications to the Plans in the event that you consider that they require such modifications in order to make them sound. I would also like to confirm that further to your correspondence, the District Council will now review the schedule of proposed minor amendments set out in documents EB001 and EB002 to ascertain whether or not it considers that any would change the scope of the policies and therefore necessitate further consultation and revised Sustainability Appraisal. The schedule will also be updated with regard to proposed amendments arising from discussions relating to the establishment of Common Ground with key stakeholders who have submitted representations on the Plans. The review will clarify those changes that are considered to be more significant and therefore would be subject to your recommendations for main modifications.
